A MESSAGE FROM THE MEDICAL CLINIC


- If you don't need your appointment please let medical know so we can see other clients.

Badac Covid 19 Update

TOWARDS THE END OF SEPTEMBER, BADAC ENTERED INTO IT'S PANDEMIC RECOVERY PLAN STAGE

- Home Visits can occur for High Priority clients, however a Covid 19 Checklist needs to be completed and PPE, hand hygiene and social distancing are required. Staff will check client's temperature before entering the home.
- Staff remain working from home for the most part, with Manager's working on site.
- No staff are travelling outside of the Ballarat area for work purposes.
- Increased cleaning is occurring
- Social media and BADAC website is being used for communication where possible
- Masks are being worn at all times in the building unless individuals are in a room on their own.
- Group programs have resumed outside with a maximum of 10 people including staff
